Feb 18th - Depart USA

Feb 20th - Arrive in Melbourne, Australia (D)

Feb 24th - Cairns Free Time (BD)

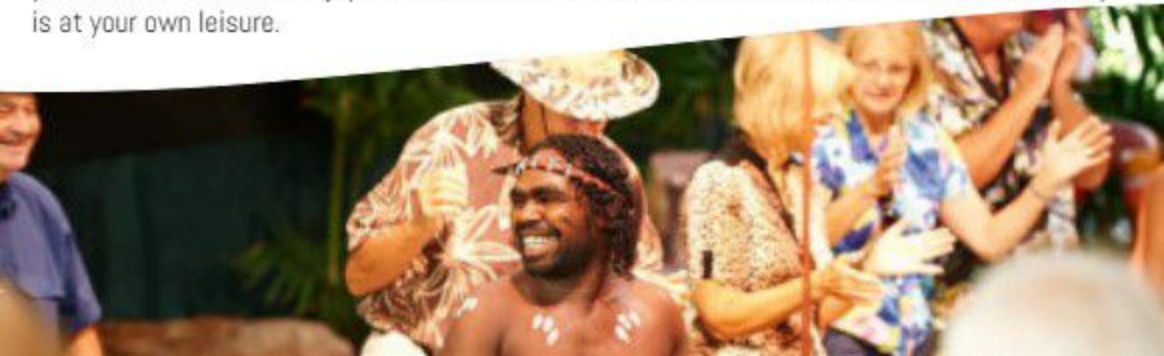
Enjoy the day at your own leisure. Join us for dinner and a show at Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park.
